



This is not an exhaustive list of all extremist signs and symbols but does show some of the flags and iconography known to have been circulated within the UK. Some are designated terrorist organisations with no footprint or aspirations within the UK but may have seen support from British individuals, which could involve travel or providing financial assistance.

The presence of a sign or symbol in isolation does not necessarily indicate criminal or extremist intent. Some symbols have religious, historical or mythological connotations and have subsequently been adopted and misappropriated by extremist groups.

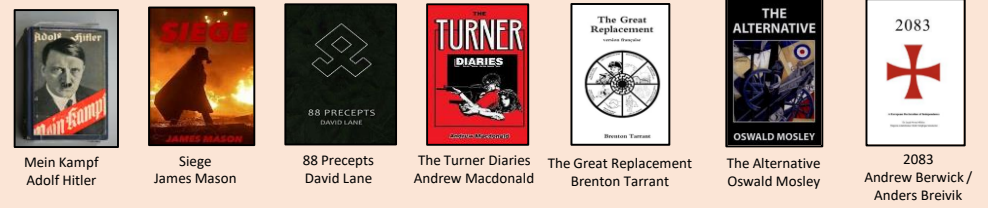
