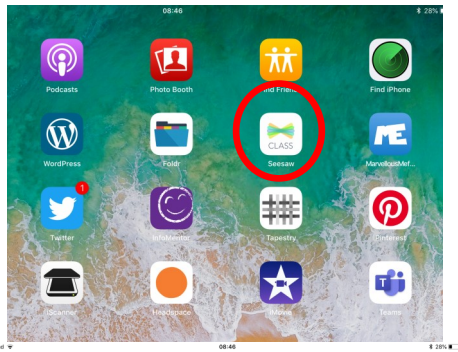


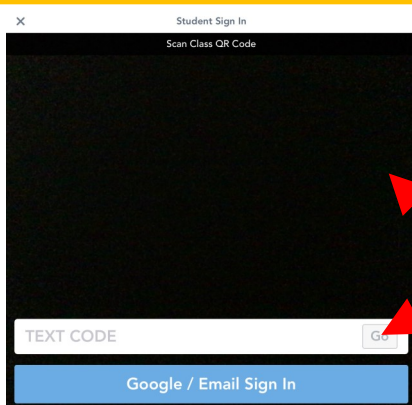
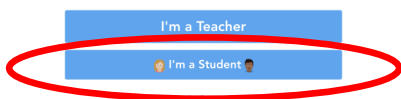
# How to access your activities on Seesaw



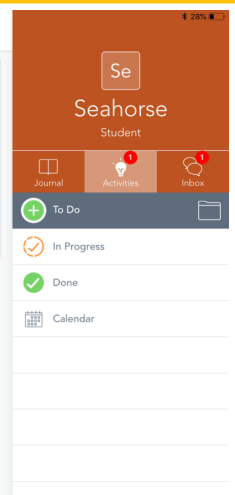
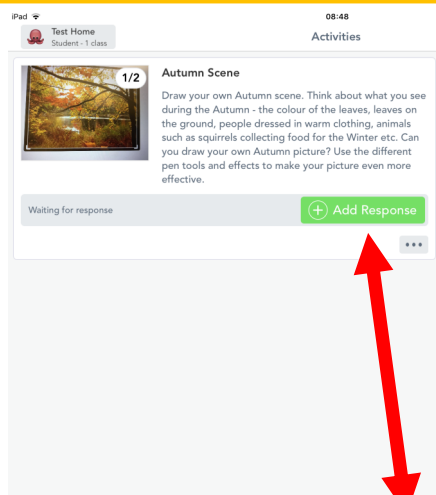
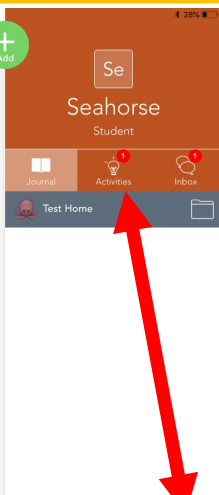
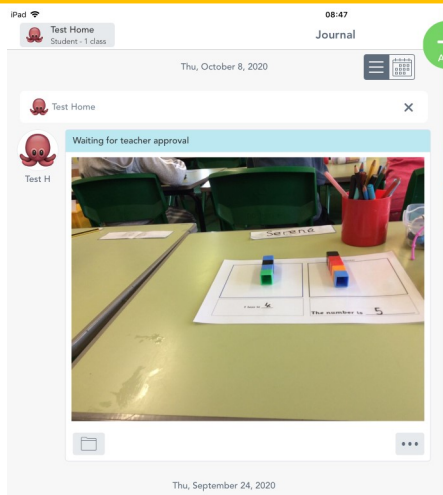
Click on the “Seesaw Class” App
